young players from 25 locations across the country.

in five phases in each of the five regions including Federal Capital, Azad Jammu & Kashmir,

Gilgit-Baltistan, Punjab, Sindh, Balochistan, and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

According to the vision of the Government of Pakistan provision of Education, Employment and Engagement opportunities to the youth of the country, HEC has been entrusted to conduct talent hunt activities to engage youth in productive activities of sports.

On this occasion, Mr. Khurram Dastgir while addressing the youngsters advised them by sharing lessons from the poetry of Allama Muhammad Iqbal, to be their own leaders and take hold of their own lives. He maintained that despite maligning the performance of state institutions, it is our utmost responsibility to do our part wholeheartedly for the development of our country.
